


Remember... It's all about them!



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Get them involved

- Opportunities for the audience to speak
- Teaching is about the students
- Learn a little bit about each other – without “go around the room”
- Consensus building/brainstorming exercise with dots
- Solicit examples from audience
- Watch for restlessness
- What’s that burning question?



Quizlet (quizlet.com)

- A fun way to study related terms
- Process:
 - Enter data
 - Flashcards – Flip back and forth
 - Learn – Type answer
 - Speller – Spell the word spoken
 - Test – fill-in and multiple choice
 - Scatter – drag & drop matching
 - Race – type the word before it disappears



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Instant Polls

- Poll Everywhere (www.polleverywhere.com)
 - Respondents use their mobile device, tweet, embedded link, web page, email
 - Types: Open, Multiple Choice, Image
 - No sign up: polls stay for 2 weeks
 - Free account: polls stay
 - Paid account: more than 40 responses per poll
- Try it out: What is one thing you learned today?
- Text 725348 and your message to 22333



Introvert vs Extrovert

Beware the draw of group work!



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Group work

- Pros
 - Provides interaction
 - Break from sitting all class
 - Break for instructor
- Cons
 - Be weary of the tolerance of the introvert
 - Just the concept can be a stressor

- Incorporate different types of media
- Methods for feedback
